

Eligibility criteria for the removal of submucosal fibroids and uterine polyps using hysteroscopic-guided myomectomy and polypectomy

Southern Cross will only reimburse the cost of the removal of submucosal fibroids and uterine polyps using hysteroscopic-guided myomectomy and polypectomy under a member's policy when either criterion **1 or 2** below are met for that member.

- 1. The following indications (i., ii., and iii.) are all present:
 - i. abnormal uterine bleeding is present and is unresponsive to medical treatments.
 - ii. when the fibroid(s) is **one** of the following:
 Type 0 submucosal fibroid over 1 cm in diameter **or**
 Type 1 submucosal fibroid.
 - iii. the pre-operative trans vaginal sonography (TVS) demonstrates that more than 50% of the submucosal fibroid(s) project(s) into the uterine cavity.
- 2. For the removal of endometrial polyps when abnormal uterine bleeding is present and is unresponsive to medical treatments.
