

Eligibility criteria for wireless capsule endoscopy

Southern Cross will only reimburse the cost of wireless capsule endoscopy under a member's policy when at least **one** of the following criteria is met for that member.

- Occult or overt gastrointestinal bleeding indicated by iron deficiency or a significant drop in haemoglobin/haemocrit, where the cause has not been diagnosed using prior gastroscopy or colonoscopy.
- 2. For investigation of suspected Crohn's disease where all criteria i., ii., iii. and iv. below are met:
 - i. persistent abdominal pain of greater than four weeks
 - ii. persistent diarrhoea
 - iii. negative stool cultures
 - iv. definitive diagnosis has not been established from prior gastroscopy or colonoscopy procedures.
- 3. For investigation of possible small bowel tumours.
- **4.** For investigation of Peutz-Jeghers syndrome.
- **5.** A repeat wireless capsule endoscopy for previously diagnosed small bowel disease requiring further investigation due to recurrence or persistence of signs or symptoms.

Please also ensure you are familiar with all **policy exclusions**, including:

- Acute care
- Congenital conditions
- Cosmetic treatment/procedures
- Health screening
- Treatment of any condition not detrimental to health
- Unapproved healthcare services.
