HTAQ application checklist: what you need before you start

- Clear clinical rationale including patient population and expected benefit.
- Full episode of care costing including hospital, specialists, diagnostics and consumables.
- Supporting documents such as clinical evidence and supplier invoices.
- Details of service delivery including provider capability and equipment.
- Awareness that submitted pricing is expected to align with contracting if approved.

Tip: providing complete information upfront helps reduce follow up and supports faster decision making.
