

Eligibility criteria for radiofrequency ablation of bone lesions - effective up to and including 20 September 2026

Southern Cross will only reimburse the cost of radiofrequency ablation of bone lesions under a member's policy when **all** of the following criteria below are met for that member.

1. The treatment is for diagnosed osteoid osteoma or other benign bone tumour shown to be responsive to radiofrequency ablation.
2. The diagnosis has been confirmed by an MRI and/or CT scan.
3. The member has been referred for the treatment by a vocationally registered orthopaedic surgeon.

Please also ensure you are familiar with all **policy exclusions**, including:

- Acute care
- Congenital conditions
- Cosmetic treatment/procedures
- Health screening
- Treatment of any condition not detrimental to health
- Unapproved healthcare services.
